Facts about Jane Austen:

Jane was born in Steventon in 1775 and her father was a clergyman who also ran a school in the family home to supplement his family's income.

In her lifetime she completed six novels, including **Northanger Abbey, Sense and Sensibility, Pride and Prejudice, Mansfield Park, Emma,** and **Persuasion**. Four of them were published before her death.

She had six brothers and one sister.

Jane never married. In 1802, Jane accepted a marriage proposal but changed her mind the following day.

None of the novels published in her lifetime gave her name.

When her first novel, **Sense and Sensibility** came out in 1811, the title page simply said "By a Lady" and even **Pride and Prejudice** only said by: "The Author of **Sense and Sensibility**".

Her novel **Pride and Prejudice** was originally called "First Impressions".
