The **deadline for completing the application form** is midnight on **Wednesday 1st July 2026.** We do not accept late applications so please complete the form in plenty of time.

Widening Horizons

- We are very proud of our Widening Horizons initiative for which we have won a Gold award for **Fair School Admissions**. We work with local primary schools and in particular students in receipt of pupil premium (free school meals), service premium (children of British military personnel) or a child in care or previously in care.
- These students are invited to our virtual Inspire Club on a Tuesday and will have access to free familiarisation material.
- The qualifying score is lowered by 5 points for these candidates.
- If your child is eligible for Widening Horizons we will contact you once you register for the test to invite your child to take part in the programme or you can email us directly.



Special Arrangements for the Test

- It is important to let us know on the application form if your child needs special arrangements for the test.
- We will discuss these with you and your child's current primary school in order to establish a history of need
- Please also let us know if your child will be bringing medication with them on the test day. Treat the test as you would a school trip.

Admission Test Day

Friday 18th September 2026

- Morning and afternoon sessions
- You cannot choose your session time
- We will advise you by email of your session time and all the test arrangements by no later than 17th July 2026



Format of Tests

- There will be two tests each of approximately one hour duration. There will be a short break between the two test sessions.
- The tests will assess English, Mathematics, Non-Verbal and Verbal Reasoning. We do not have a creative writing element to the tests.
- The raw scores will be age standardised and the ranking is determined by the aggregate of the age standardised scores of both papers

Familiarisation Material

- Kendrick School do not support or promote tutoring for the admissions tests as the test outcomes should be an indicator of the child's natural academic ability and their potential to benefit from the kind of academic education provided at Kendrick School
- There is familiarisation material from GL assessment available via our website to ensure that your child is familiar with the types of questions that could be asked.

Admission Test Day – What to Bring

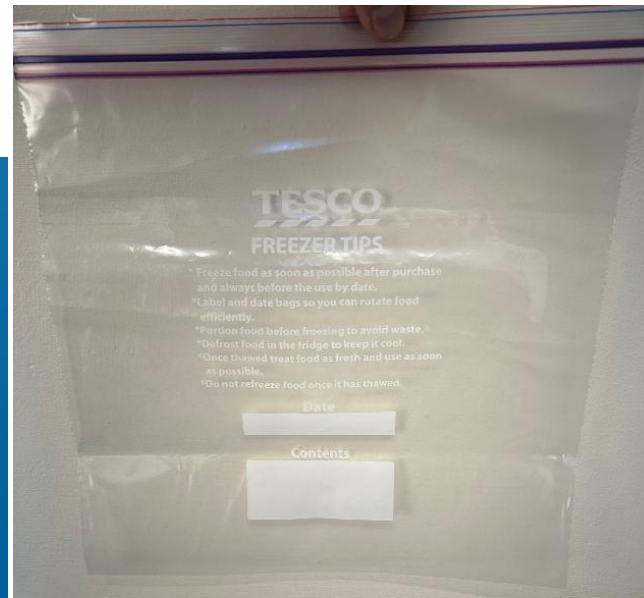
In a clear pencil case and/or small clear bag your child will **ONLY** need the following items:
