FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

The session I want to attend is fully booked. What can I do?

Please add your name to the waiting list and you will be sent an email if a place becomes available. You have 5 hours from receiving this email to accept the offer of a ticket.

Can I book for more than one session

Please do not book more than one session. Each session is identical. Due to the demand for tickets each family can only book one ticket and we will delete the latest booking if we feel that the booking is a duplicate. This is to allow for as many families as possible to attend.

I can no longer attend the event. How do I cancel?

There is a cancellation link at the end of the email that you will receive to confirm the tickets. Alternatively please email admissions@kendrick.reading.sch.uk and we will cancel the tickets for you.

I live outside the designated area. Can I attend the event?

No. Due to the demand for tickets, the event is for families that live in our designated area only. Please see the information on our website [here](#) regarding applying to Kendrick School from outside of our designated area.

Is there parking at the school?

We are unable to offer parking for the event. We suggest parking in the Oracle Shopping Centre or the Queen's Road car park and walking the short distance to the school.

Where do I enter the school?

Entry to the school will be at the London Road gates. You will be waiting outside so please ensure you are dressed appropriately for the weather. Once registration has ended and the gates are closed, latecomers will not be able to gain access to the school.

What time should I arrive?

Please arrive at the time allocated for your session. You will be waiting outside for registration so please ensure you are dressed appropriately for the weather.

How long is each session?

Each session is one and a half hours long. Please note that, for safeguarding purposes, you will not be able to leave the school once a session has started. Please ensure you have allowed adequate time and parking for your visit.

How many people can I bring with me?

The ticket is for 3 people, one of which must include the Year 5 child. For example one ticket could admit 2x adults and 1x Year 5 child; OR 1x adult and 1x Year 5 child and 1x sibling; OR 1x adult and 1x Year 5 child. However, for safeguarding reasons you must have your Year 5 child with you or you will not be given access to the school.

Can I attend the event without my Year 5 child?

No, for safeguarding reasons you must bring your Year 5 child with you to the event. Adults without a child will not be allowed access to the school.

Can I bring my younger child with me?

Younger children will be counted as one of the 3 people admitted on the ticket. So, if both parents want to come along, they must bring their Year 5 child and therefore younger siblings will not be able to attend as well.

Is there somewhere to store my bicycle?

Unfortunately we cannot store bicycles safely on the school grounds. There are bike racks outside the front of the school in East Street, however, they will be left at your own risk.

Can my child bring their scooter?

No, for health and safety reasons we cannot allow scooters on the tours. There are bike racks outside the front of the school in East Street, however, they will be left at your own risk.

Can I bring a pushchair?

No, for health and safety reasons we cannot accommodate pushchairs around the school.
