Inspiring Women



Jill Scott MBE Jill is best known for her outstanding performance in the women's Euro 2022 team that went on to win the nail-biting competition. The Lioness kicked off her football career with her home city's women's team before joining Everton Women in 2006 and Manchester City in 2013.

Jill's career highlights include winning the Women's Super League title with City in 2017, scoring England's winner against Holland in the Euro 2009 semi-finals, and representing Great Britain at the 2012 Olympics. The sportswoman was appointed a Member of the Order of the British Empire (MBE) in the 2020 New Year Honours, for services to women's football. And in August this year, Jill retired as England's second-most capped international footballer (men and women).
