



Ellie Simmonds OBE- Paralympian

Ellie Simmonds was born on 11 November 1994 in <u>Walsall</u>. She has achondroplasia, a common cause of <u>dwarfism</u>, and has been interested in <u>swimming</u> since the age of five. At the age of 11 she moved to <u>Swansea</u> to use the city's top swimming pool.



She is best known as a gold medal-winning Paralympic swimmer and broadcaster. She came to national attention when she competed in the 2008 Summer Paralympics in Beijing, winning two gold medals for Great Britain. She was the youngest member of the team, at the age of 13. She was given



an <u>MBE</u> in the 2009 New Year Honours, and was the youngest person to ever be handed this accolade at just 14. In the 2013 New Year Honours, she received an <u>OBE</u> for her services to Paralympic sport.

Ellie participated in Strictly Come Dancing 2022 In 2021, she announced her Paralympic retirement after missing

out on a medal in the <u>Tokyo 2020 Paralympics</u>.

Outside of her sporting career Ellie studied <u>Psychology</u> at Loughborough University in England. She is also very involved with charity work - with much of her focus being on sports, young people and water.
