Class Representative System

To encourage communication between families and help them and the students get to know each other, the Kendrick Parents' Society (KPS) runs a **Class Parent Rep System** for each form in the School.

The main role of the Class Parent Rep is to maintain a list of student/parent and carer contacts. Through this way of communication, parents and carers can get to know what is going on in School and in particular, their child's form and year and help in planning the KPS initiatives and fund-raising events.
