In order to celebrate Pride month, we, the KSLT, are proposing the project, '**Pebbles for Pride**'. The details below tell you what you, as staff or student, have to do to participate:

The project consists of each person finding a stone or pebble, painting a design on said pebble, with the theme of Pride in mind, and placing this out in the wilderness! Whether you are a member of the LGBTQ+ community or not, this is a good way to show our support for those who are! It is advised to use acrylic paint, but nail polish is a good alternative.

Any Pride Pebbles should be photographed and sent to 14lzhao@kendrick.reading.sch.uk to be posted on the Kendrick Arts Instagram account, along with your name and year (if you are a student). The last day to send your pebble in is the last day of term, which is the **17th of July**.

If you cannot find a pebble, or do not have paint, here are a few alternatives:

- Photoshop a design onto a pebble and send this image to us.
- Use nail polish instead of paint.
- Create anything else Pride-themed, such as a rainbow cake!

If you are able to, make sure you add a layer of PVA glue on top of the dried paint design, as this will make it waterproof.
