# Message from Ms Kattirtzi, Headteacher

I have mentioned the highlights of this term in previous updates and the school has continued to be busy and active in these last few weeks. The examination season is well under way and I have been impressed with our Year 11 students who are approaching their GCSE examinations with a quiet and focused attitude, arriving on time (even yesterday, when the traffic was terrible due to an accident on the M4) and carefully and methodically getting through these challenging examinations. Today our Year 10 start their exams. I hope all our senior students take a bit of a rest in the coming week and some relaxation in between their revision so that they can recharge and refresh to manage the rest of the examination period.

Last December we submitted a Conditions Improvement Fund (CIF) application to the Education and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA) for two projects to improve the facilities in the school. One of the bids was to address structural problems in Sidmouth House and the second bid was to improve our canteen and eating facilities. I am delighted to say that we were successful in both these bids and an investment of around £520,000 will be spent on the school in the coming months. There will be some disruption to everyone whilst the improvement works take place but our contractors will try to keep this to a minimum. We hope that the end results, in particular, the improvement to our dining facilities, will be worth the inconvenience. In order to add weight to our bids, we had to commit some funding to the overall costs. Some of this funding will come from the Kendrick Trust and a portion from School Fund. Again I will write to you in more detail about this next term and ask for further support with this funding. We will also put the plans on our website for people to see the small extension to the Library that has been planned to improve the dining facilities. Nest term I shall be writing to you about some exciting and significant longer term strategic plans for the school.

Ms Case, PD/Art Technician and Mrs Agarwal, Science Technician, are leaving us today. We thank them for their dedication and service to the school and wish them well in their future plans. Last week Mrs Whittaker left to begin her maternity leave, we look forward to receiving her news in due course and I would like to welcome back Mrs Kenward who has returned from her maternity leave.

I would like to end this term's Weekly Update with a lovely news item that we have put on our website: <a href="#">140</a>
Inspirational Quotes. As you can see from the item, two Year 9 students, Anwita and Abi, organised a super activity last autumn as part of our 140<sup>th</sup> Birthday celebrations.
