The Grants

- Each year the Trustees are able to give two grants
 - Kendrick Trust Edmonstone Bequest Travel Scholarships up to £500
 - Kendrick Trust MM Towne Memorial Music and Arts Grants

- The award is about developing musical skills to lead to increased wellbeing and is an annual award of £250

- The award is £500 towards university or training associated costs where the student is studying a STEM subject.


Year Groups
