 ISP -year 11 independent study period

3 or 4 A Level programs are possible for Year 12 with the option of taking 1 AS at the end of Year 12 for those students on the 4 A Level program.

3 A Level courses is standard for year 13. Some students opt to take 4 A Level Subjects

GCE Options are Art and Design, Biology, Chemistry, Drama and Theatre Studies, Economics, English Literature, French, Geography, German, History, Latin, Mathematics, Further Mathematics,,

Music, PE, Physics, Philosophy and Ethics, Sociology

AS and A Level students are offered free choice in their subject combination and the timetable and blocks are constructed based on those choices.

DSP = Directed independent study period for years 12 and 13. Each subject has 8 taught lessons and 2 DSP per 2 week cycle except year 12 Biology, Chemistry and Physics which have 9 taught lessons and 1 DSP.

PS = Private Study
