

Uniform Expectations in KS4 2025-26

Shirts	Always need to be tucked in when wearing a jumper and looking presentable. No black layer under your shirt, please. White one is acceptable.
Jumpers	Should be worn (unless it is too hot) and not replaced by a jacket/windbreaker.
Skirts, Shorts and Trousers	<p>Skirts need to be pleated and of appropriate length (see picture for perfect length or below) and not rolled up. Trousers and shorts should be tailored, either black or dark grey and made from an appropriate material. Any school shorts should be knee length. If staff need to challenge you on this continually, you will be given a replacement item from the school that you will need to wear.</p> 
Shoes	<p>Should provide adequate support and protection for ankle/heel/foot. Should be black and not a trainer or boot, no visible label. Discuss with tutor/KS4 team if unsure. No long socks. E.G.</p> 
Piercings	One small stud in each ear (2 in total). No facial piercings are allowed. Religious piercing will have to wait until after GCSEs.
Jewellery	No jewellery should be worn besides two small studs in ear. Bracelets and anklets are not allowed. If a student is wearing religious jewellery, they will need to speak directly with Mme Hulley and have approval regarding this or may, otherwise, be asked by staff to remove the item. In any case no jewellery other than 2 studs should be seen.
Hair Colour and Hair Style	<p>Natural hair colour only. No vibrant colours (pink/blue/purple etc).</p> <p>Hair should be kept out of face (with slides/pins, being tied back, plaited etc). Your face should be easily seen, and your appearance look professional.</p>
Nail Polish	Only clear nail polish allowed.
Makeup	Make-up worn should be discreet and appropriate for a school environment.
