

## Uniform Expectations 2024-2025 for KS3

<b>Shirts</b>	Always need to be tucked in and looking presentable.
<b>Jumpers</b>	Should be worn and not replaced of a jacket/windbreaker.
<b>Skirts, Shorts and Trousers</b>	<p>Skirts need to be pleated and of appropriate length (just above/on the knee) and not rolled up. Trousers and shorts should be tailored, either black or dark grey and appropriate material. Any school shorts should be knee length. If staff need to challenge you on this continually, you will be given a skirt/short/trouser from the school that you will need to wear.</p> 
<b>Shoes</b>	<p>Should provide adequate support and protection for ankle/heel/foot. Should be black and not a trainer. Discuss with tutor/KS3 team if unsure. <b>Piercings</b>	One small stud in each ear (2 in total). No facial piercings are allowed.
<b>Jewellery</b>	No jewellery should be worn besides two small studs in ear. Bracelets and anklets are not allowed. If a student is wearing religious jewellery, they will need to speak directly with Miss Hyde and have approval regarding this otherwise, may be asked by staff to remove the item.
<b>Hair Colour and Hair Style</b>	<p>Natural hair colour only. No vibrant colours (pink/blue/purple etc).</p> <p>Hair should be kept out of face (with slides/pins, being tied back, plaited etc). Your face should be easily able to be seen, and your appearance look professional.</p>
<b>Nail Polish</b>	Only clear nail polish allowed.
<b>Makeup</b>	The make-up worn should be discreet and appropriate for a school environment.
