Remote Learning Plan for students (last updated January 2021)

Register, COVID and IT support

1. Students complete a daily Google form by 8.40am to establish their working conditions and to request contact with their tutor or TLC.
2. Parents must contact the school in the event of a positive COVID 19 test result and other illness.
3. Those with insufficient means to access remote learning long term can be supported by the school with: borrowing computers, delivered assessments.

Tutoring and support

4. Tutors to run a tutor time *at least* weekly and be available at tutor time throughout the week.
5. School counsellor appointments continue to run remotely.

Teaching and Learning

6. Remote learning safeguarding protocols will be followed at all times.
7. Remote learning follows the existing school timetable and aims to teach the same curriculum as we do in school with adaptations to practical work. Curriculum coverage is very likely, however, to be slower during periods of remote learning and subjects will build this into their longer term planning.
8. Teachers will avoid overrunning lessons and, if possible, reduce live lessons to 20-40 minutes to allow students to complete work and have rest breaks.
9. Live lessons, for all year groups, will be recorded and shared if requested. Live lesson may also be introductory to guide the work set.
10. Weekly work can be set by teachers in advance, including for a chain of lessons.
11. Homework will only be set in small amounts for KS3 students.
12. All tasks and set work in lessons will be clearly time bonded.
13. Students who do not engage with remote learning and emails from their teachers, or with the work set, will be contacted by the attendance and welfare team, then by the pastoral team.
14. Teachers will take into consideration extra time for relevant students.
15. SEN students will be monitored for workload and support using updated SEN passports for guidance.

The Headteacher has overarching responsibility for the quality and delivery of remote education.
